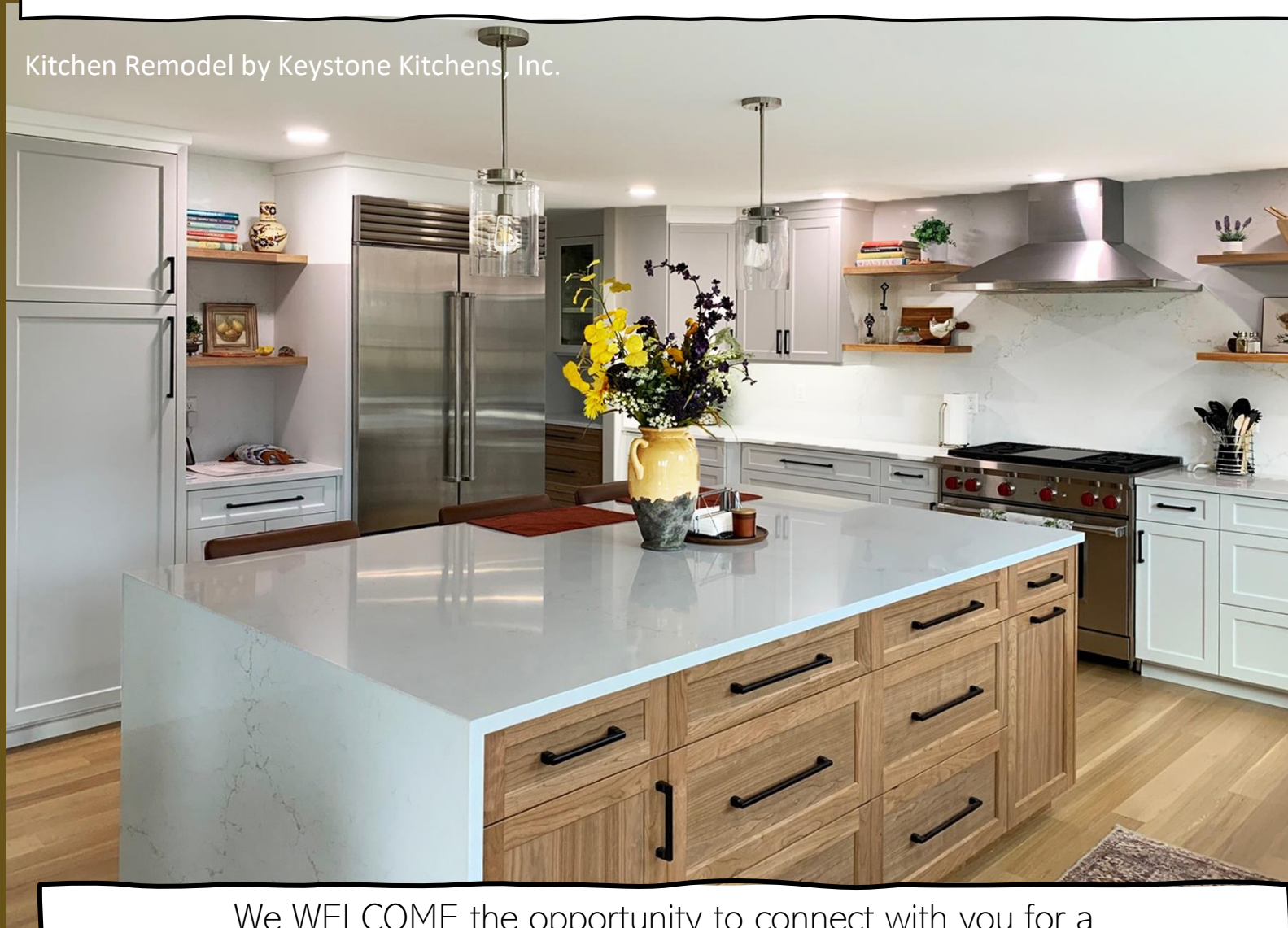

Q: What is Sintered Stone?

A: Sintered stone is a unique countertop material that combines many of the design and appearance positives of favorites like quartz or granite countertops, while eliminating negatives (absorption and heat sensitivity). Sintered stone feels like real stone; it is a hybrid of real stone. It is a synthetic surfacing material made entirely of minerals and formed by heat. It does not contain resins and binders. The materials are heated to such a high temperature and pressed that the minerals fuse, becoming their own binder. Sintered stone begins with recycled materials like quartz, porcelain, and glass, along with raw minerals. These materials are ground to a fine powder and are fired to extremely high temperatures (over 1,000°C or 1,832°F) until they sinter—and form a cohesive mass short of melting.

Sintered stone is durable. Hot pans can rest on this surface without melting or scorching. It can be chopped on, cut on, scratched, stained, and scored, to little or no effect. UV rays will not fade the material and freeze-thaw events will not crack sintered stone.
