custom painted cabinets

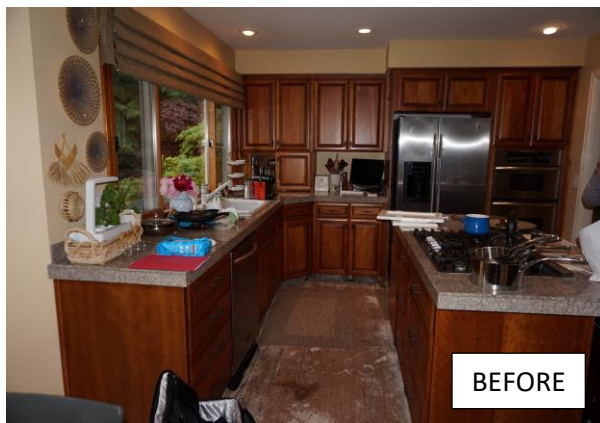
Granite tile and grout countertops

The 3D drawings that we produce are a great tool during the kitchen and bathroom planning process. A lot of our customers are visual people. It's important to understand what goes where, sightlines and how to move around in the kitchen BEFORE your kitchen is built and installation begins.



Tile Backsplash 101:

If you want your tile backsplash **grout joints** to be less noticeable, try matching closely in color to the tile OR choose a slightly lighter grout color than the tile. Grout joint thickness is important, too! Rectified tile may be installed with thinner grout joints (while handmade or irregular shaped tile will need a thicker grout joint for a quality installation). If you want to put an emphasis on the actual shape of the tile, choose a contrasting color grout. Notice the undertones! If you put the grout sample next to a piece of white paper, you may be able to see those undertones easier or sandwich different samples together and see the differences! It's ideal if all decisionmakers (homeowners) weigh in on this decision!
