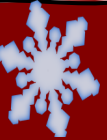

## Backsplash TILE Design 101:

The kitchen backsplash remains timeless. It is a vertical extension to the countertop which protects the walls from unintended splashes of water, grease splatter or anything else in this space. Backsplashes can extend a few inches high, go to the bottom of the upper cabinets or go as high as the ceiling. They are more than just functional. Planned with care and an eye towards the aesthetics, backsplashes can be a beautiful addition here. The backsplash, countertops, cabinetry and flooring should be coordinated into the overall design scheme. Design professionals are strong in this area for thoughtful planning a unified space and avoiding mistakes with scale, pattern, texture, and color.

### **Question: Why this backsplash wall works**

**Answer:** The patterned ceramic tile draws your eye into a focal point (the range wall) which adds interest to the neutral cabinetry. A small punch of interest goes a long way. The shallow, utility shelf thoughtfully separates the transition to the continuous wall tile. The very subtle variation adds enough depth to add variety among the individual squares; the grout colors and joint thicknesses separate all the tile well. A darker grout shows high contrast. A lighter grout is less noticeable and goes away. The slightly varied upper tiles are a quieter finish and complete the look. Color unifies all these choices.
